My background is in feminist political economy, in studies of precarious labour in which many women, particularly in the Global South, are located. Working on 'gender and media' now for the past couple of years, I have come to appreciate even more the symbiotic relationship between discourse and practice. Struggles won in other arenas need to be won too at the level of discourse; as my Latin American friends say, a transformation of the 'imaginario social' is paramount to enable new ways of thinking and doing.
